













# Symbols

The interventions that will be proposed in the upcoming chapters will be supported by symbols below. These symbols are created by using the issues, contextual analysis and strategy. The symbols are derived from the determined conditions, the strategy and the contextual analysis. The symbols on the left show the type of intervention, the efficiency of an intervention (costs + impact + timeframe = efficiency) and the level of innovation. The symbols on the right show the target groups for the interventions and the type of improvements that an intervention is going to make. On the left side of the intervention pages, these symbols will be shown. These symbols will be used to describe the interventions. The symbols will give a quick indication of the content of the interventions.
