

**Rates Statutory tuition fee academic year 2020-2021: Enrolment starting September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**

Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences charges the statutory tuition fee only if you have met the following two requirements:

**1 The nationality principle:**

- you have the EEA\*, Swiss or Surinamese nationality or
- you have valid residence permit or

~Type I: Ordinary Temporary Residence Permit

You are only qualified for the statutory tuition fee for a course in case of some restrictions. The restrictions which qualify you for the statutory tuition fee are stated below. The restriction is mentioned on the back side of the residence card.

- Unaccompanied minor foreign national
- Stay for adoption or as a foster child
- Readmission
- Stay as a foreign national who cannot leave the Netherlands through no fault of his own
- Based on a ministerial decree
- The prosecution of human trafficking (B9)
- Special arrangement 2007 (general amnesty)
- Temporary humanitarian grounds
- Child's pardon
- Pursuant to Aliens Act circular B2
- Pursuant to Article 8 of the ECHR
- Residence in connection with family formation (depending on the nationality condition of the person with whom you are staying)
- Family extension (depending on the nationality condition of the person with whom you are staying)
- Stay with family member (depending on the nationality condition of the person with whom you are staying)
- Continued residence (whether you are entitled depends on your 1<sup>st</sup> residence permit)
- Non-temporary humanitarian grounds ((whether you are entitled depends on your 1<sup>st</sup> residence permit)

~Type IV: Asylum Permanent Residence Permit

**2 You have not yet obtained a degree in case of a request for enrolment for a:**

- Associate degree programme: you have not obtained a associate degree, bachelor or master degree in the Netherlands yet.
- Bachelor's degree programme; you have not obtained a bachelor degree in the Netherlands yet.
- Master's degree programme; you have not obtained a master degree in the Netherlands yet.

If you already have obtained a associate degree, bachelor or master but this is the first time you apply for a course programme in 'health care' or 'education', you are qualified for the legal tuition fee, on the condition that you have not yet obtained a degree in 'health care' or 'education'.
